

Backshop Storage Rules and Regulations

CLEAR WALKWAYS

The 5' wide Walkways at the East and West ends of the tracks separate the storage track area from the Rollup Doors. This area is always to be kept clear of trains and other stuff.

WORK ON TRAINS OUTSIDE

If you need to work on your trains, please move them outside or into the Backshop's Southern Bay where the shop area is. The Middle and Northern Bays are for storage only.

MOVING TRAINS

You may need to move trains to get access to your train. Please be respectful of the other person's train. Move it out, Move your train out, and then put the other person's train back before you work on your train. If you do not know how to move a train, get help. If the train had covers on it, please put the covers back in place.

STORE YOUR TRAINS, NOT YOUR STUFF

Everything in the Backshop must roll on the rails. Nothing is to be set on the rails or along side the tracks.

DISCONNECTED BATTERIES

Batteries must be disconnected while in storage. Batteries that are no longer usable may not be stored in or adjacent to Backshop. Such batteries should be disposed of in accordance with DEQ and State Fire Marshall regulations.

NO GAS

Gasoline may be stored in fuel tanks installed in equipment. Gasoline may not be stored in fuel tanks that are not installed in equipment. No gasoline is to be transferred from storage can to engine, from storage can to storage can or from engine to storage can inside the Backshop. All pumping out of gasoline from tanks shall be performed outside the Backshop.
